Environmental considerations

RES will design the solar farm so that it will fit sensitively in the surrounding landscape.

A number of surveys and assessments will be carried out to ensure any potential impact upon the environment, landscape, heritage and local residents is appropriately assessed and mitigated. Potential cumulative impacts, with other developments in the area, will also be assessed. The assessments to be carried out will include:

- Ecology
- Flood risk & surface water management
- Landscape and Visual
- Heritage & Archaeology
- Glint and Glare
- National Land Capability for Agriculture
- Traffic and transport
- Acoustics

The results of these surveys, along with feedback from the local community and stakeholders, will be taken into account as the design of the solar farm is refined and finalised. The assessments will accompany any planning application that is made.
